Keanu decided to be an actor at the age of 15, when he had a few acting lessons and became hooked. He spent some time working in a pasta restaurant and sharpening skates at an ice hockey rink in order to pay his way. He went to auditions between shifts and got various parts in local theatre and TV productions, as well as a part in Coca-Cola advert.

After *Youngblood* Keanu starred in several other films, but it wasn't until 1991, when he was given the part of Ted in *Bill and Ted's Excellent Adventure*, that he started to make a name for himself.

Producers were desperate to have Keanu back for the sequel, *Speed 2: Cruise Control* but he shocked everyone by rejecting the reported £9 million offer to tour Europe, America and Japan with his band Dogstar, in which he plays bass guitar.

So what else does he get up to? In reality he has no home at all. Instead, he lives out of a suitcase and flits from one five star hotel to another. We also know that he's into motorbikes in a big way and that the reckless rider had had two accidents, one in which he broke an ankle and the other which left him with a 25-centimetre navel-to-chest scar.

Keanu likes to do things properly and once he gets a role, he loves getting his teeth into it. However, despite his good looks, a successful career and vast sums of money, Keanu claims: 'Life isn't a bowl of cherries and I don't consider myself a happy person.'
